- Turf restoration by the main entrance
- Add bark to all common areas except the tot lot
- Look into pruning the birch trees

There was some question regarding fixing the light bulbs at the main entrance. It was unknown the warranty time line on some of the bulbs and which ones specifically needed to be fixed. Keith said he would follow up with JP.

Keith and Karen agreed to follow-up with Laura from the city regarding the trees that need to be replaced within TR. There was discussion of a joint letter from TRHOA and the city outlining steps for this topic.

## **Treasurer's Report**

Karen mentioned that full payment has been received from one of the homeowners in arrears. She also stated the house on the corner of 278<sup>th</sup> and 156<sup>th</sup> pl has consistent maintenance and a dedicated company. Karen has contact information if there are any future issues or questions.
